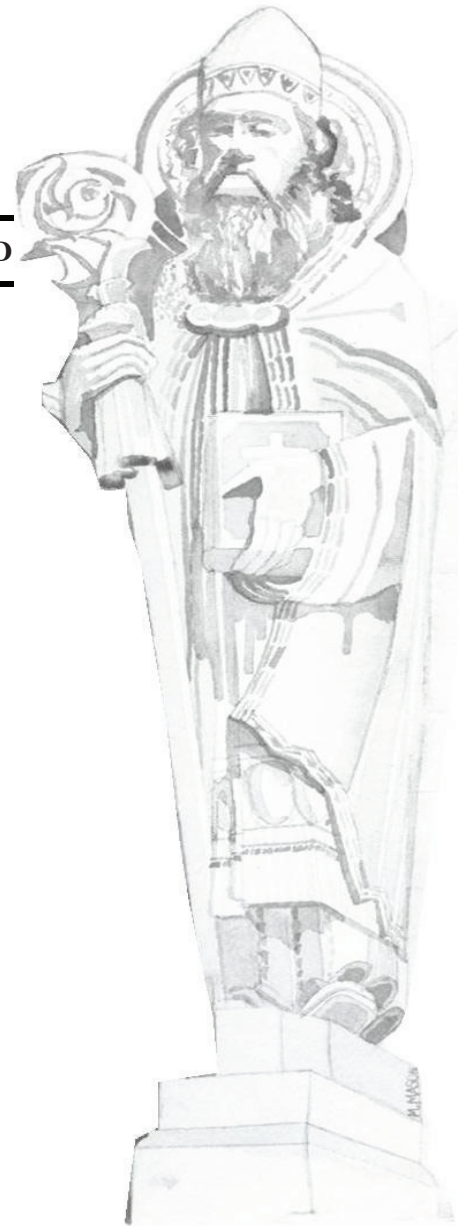

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Today's feast adds a new and central feature to the Christian message. Jesus is not solely the Jewish Messiah; he comes for the entire world. In Christ, all barriers will fall. It teaches us that in Christ there is no room for religious elitism. It may sound like a time-worn truth, but it still bears repeating: in God's eyes all are equal. In the early church, this meant not only common worship attended by all but a common table as well. St. Paul reminded us today we are not all co-heirs, co-members and co-partners. In the Body of Christ we are one. We are called to a classless society in a Christian sense. As we begin the new year, we are challenged to reflect our beliefs in our daily activities with one another, especially the difficult challenges and the people we meet.
