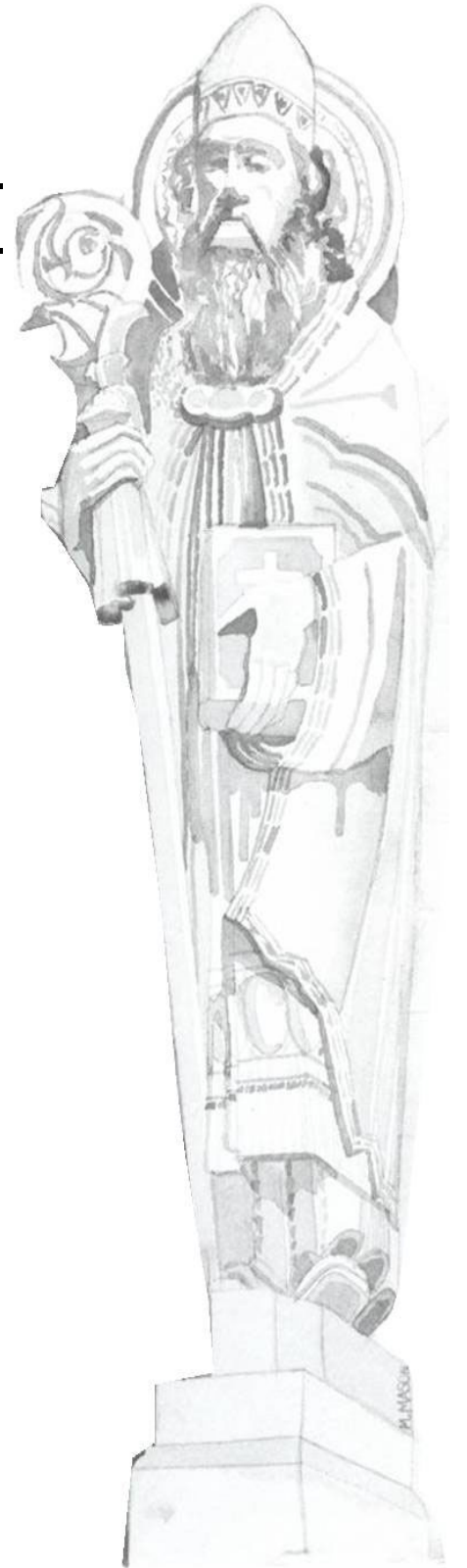

BLESSING OF THE THROATS

St. Blaise was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. According to various accounts he was a physician before becoming a bishop. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat. In the United States the annual blessing of the throats is a traditional sign of the struggle against illness in the life of a Christian. This blessing is given on Thursday, February 3rd, the memorial of St. Blaise. The opportunity to receive this blessing will be offered at the following times on Thursday, February 3rd: following the 8:30 am Mass and 6:30 pm.
