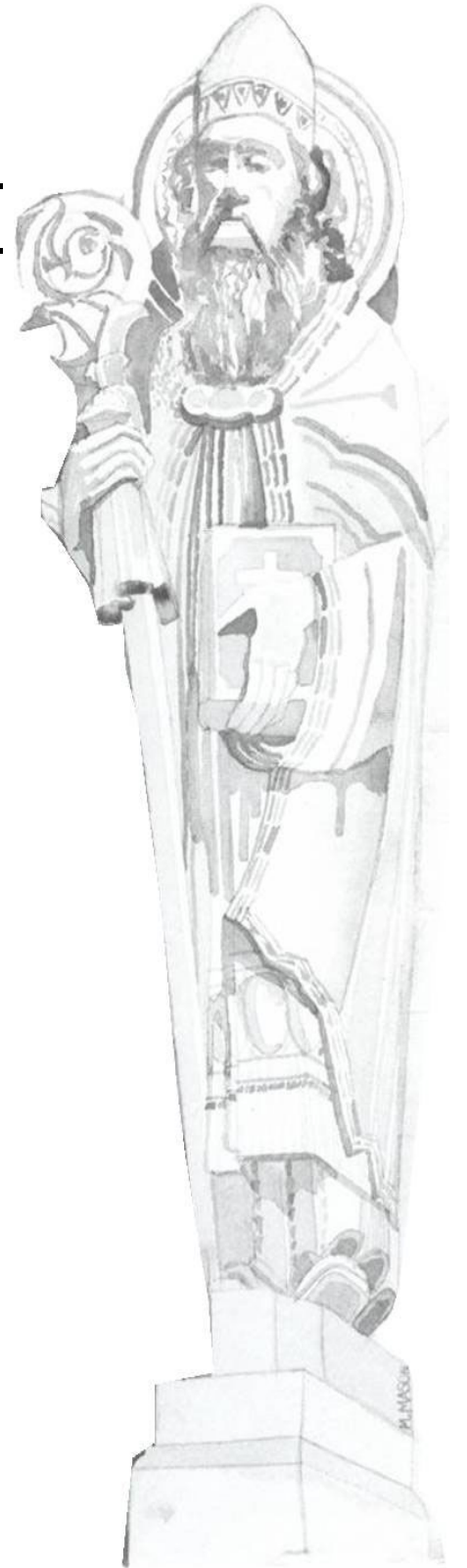

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

St. Paul reminds us today that “eye has not seen, ear has not heard...what God has prepared for those who love Him.” He clearly states that God has revealed this wisdom to us through the Spirit. What, then, is this wisdom and how do we reflect it? It is a vision whereby we see with different eyes. It is the mysterious power to love everyone, the superhuman ability to forgive even the worst of enemies, the knowledge that all suffering leads to resurrection. The enjoyment of this hidden wisdom is not reserved to a select few such as the great mystics of the Christian tradition. It is available to all who believe, to all who are willing to take pains to look where human eyes ordinarily do not look, to struggle to hear what human ears usually miss - the teachings and example of Jesus himself.
