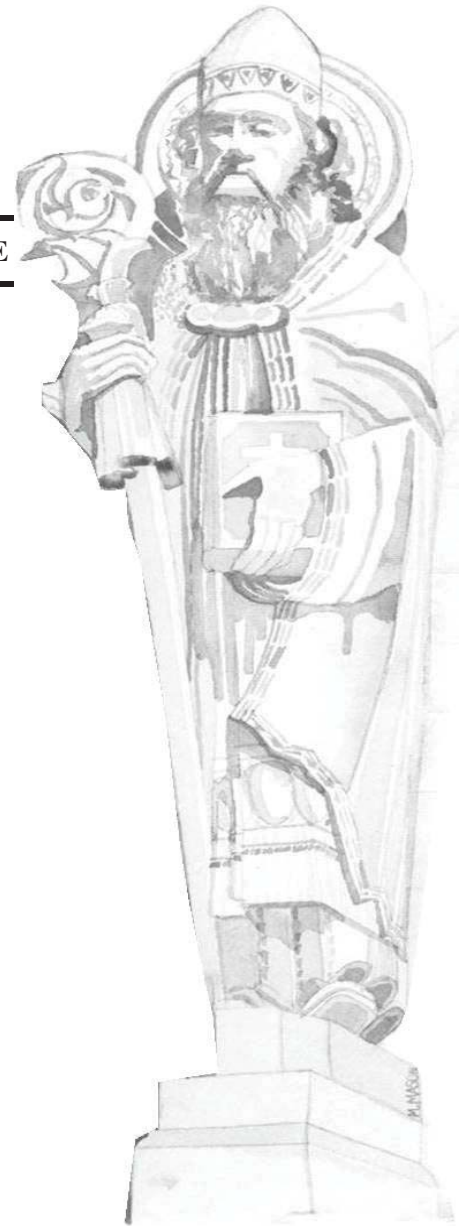

St. Paul reminds us today that "eye has not seen, ear has not heard...what God has prepared for those who love Him." He clearly states that God has revealed this wisdom to us through the Spirit. What, then, is this wisdom and how do we reflect it? It is a vision whereby we see with different eyes.
