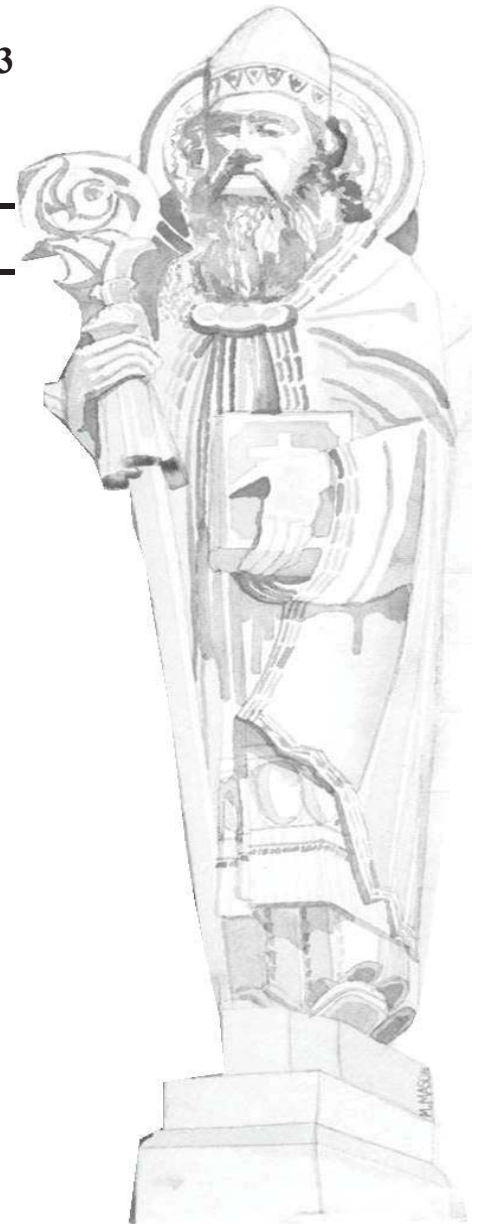

FROM THE DESK OF FR. KUNKEL

One of the most common failures of our human condition is to take things for granted, especially those which have become very familiar to us or which are very simple. Jesus was rejected by the people of his home town of Nazareth because he was too familiar to them and his background too simple; they took him for granted. There is a real danger that we may take the Mass for granted because it seems so familiar and so simple to us. Actually the Mass is a wonderful experience. As you drive or walk to church, or in the few moments you may have before Mass begins, make the effort to impress on yourself what is about to happen. Say to yourself: "God is about to speak to me in the scriptures, and I will speak to God in the prayers Jesus will make the great sacrifice of the cross truly present on this altar and he will give me the opportunity, with my fellow Catholics here, to join with him in this offering to the Father. Then I will receive Jesus in Holy Communion as a pledge of my own resurrection as well as a means of strength to carry on until the day of resurrection." It will take you even less time to make this reflection than it takes me now. Then when Mass is over spend a moment or two in reflecting on what has happened, to try to realize that you must strive to live a life in accord with the offering of yourself to God. The Mass, simple and familiar though it be, is just too important to take for granted.
