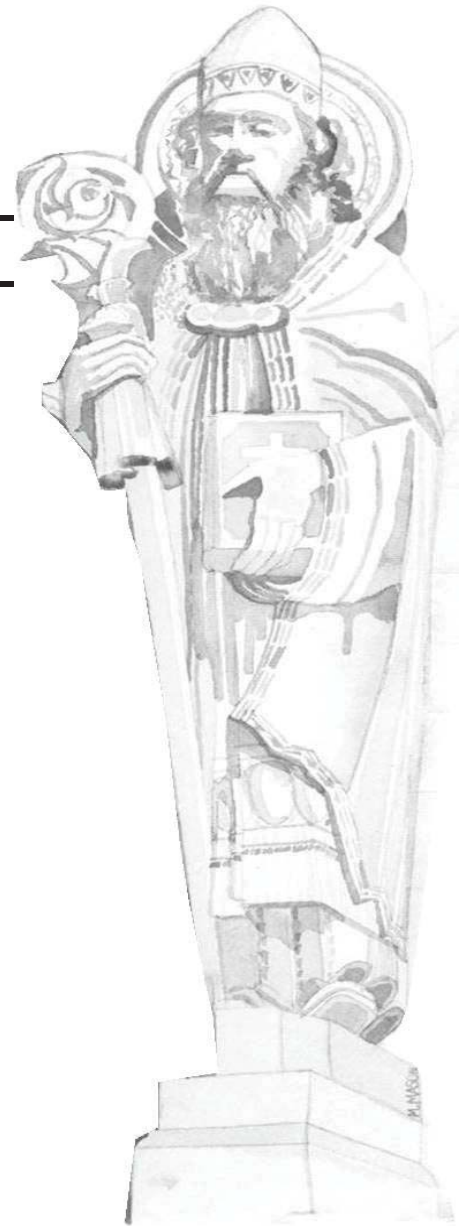

THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

In the Mass of Christian Burial, the preface reminds us that, for the Christian, in death “life is changed, not taken away.” Death is a transition, not a terminal experience. The major death-life moment for the Christian occurs in Baptism. From that point, there is a growth in life which blossoms into full engagement in God. In every death, of course, there is the pain of separation. But there is also cause for rejoicing if we truly accept the Word of God, if we believe in the Lazarus story. It is not the “grim reaper” who greets us but the loving Lord who has gone before us. As Paul reminds us “Why are we afraid?” If God loved us enough to give us his Son, will he abandon us now? God promises that He will see us. Christ will come to us as surely as He came to Lazarus. Do we truly take Him at His word?
