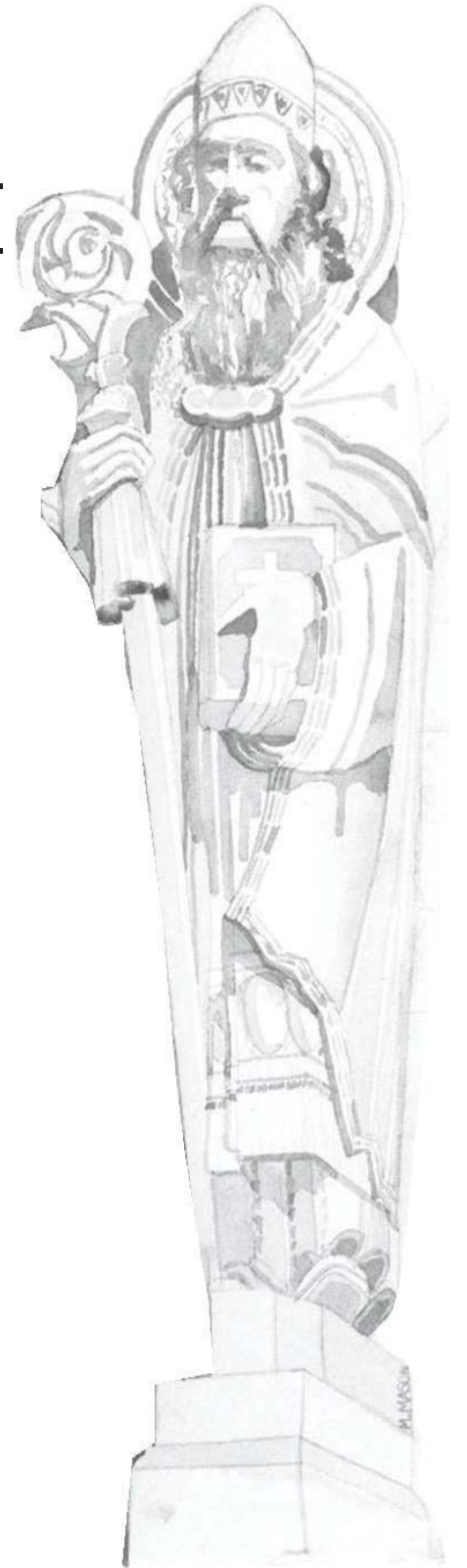

In the Diocese of Pittsburgh, being a deacon can certainly be a full time commitment, but in most cases, unless the deacon is retired, he performs his work on a part time basis. Most part time deacons, in addition to their full time careers, work 10 to 16 hours per week in their diaconate assignment. That number can be more or less, depending on the deacon's work and family situation. As we have been instructed from the very beginning, our life order of priorities is family, job and then the diaconate. So a deacon has to be extremely careful to budget and balance his time appropriately to not take away from his family or job. Next, I will answer the question, "Can a Deacon be Married?"
