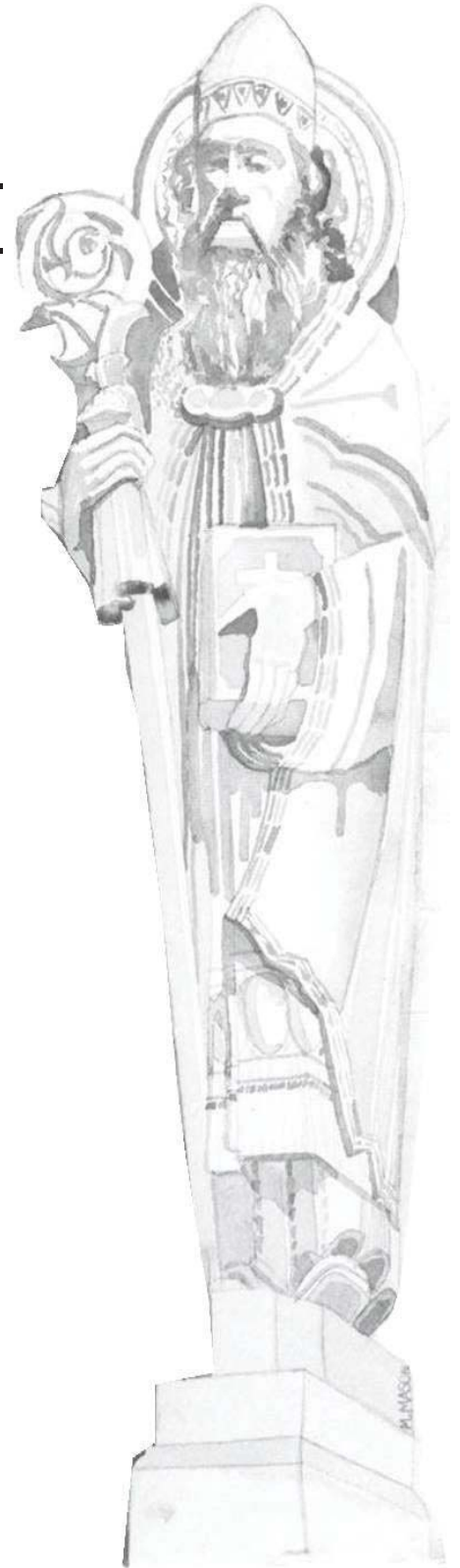

FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Our reading from 1 Peter today describes the church as a spiritual building constructed of living stones with Jesus Christ as the cornerstone.
