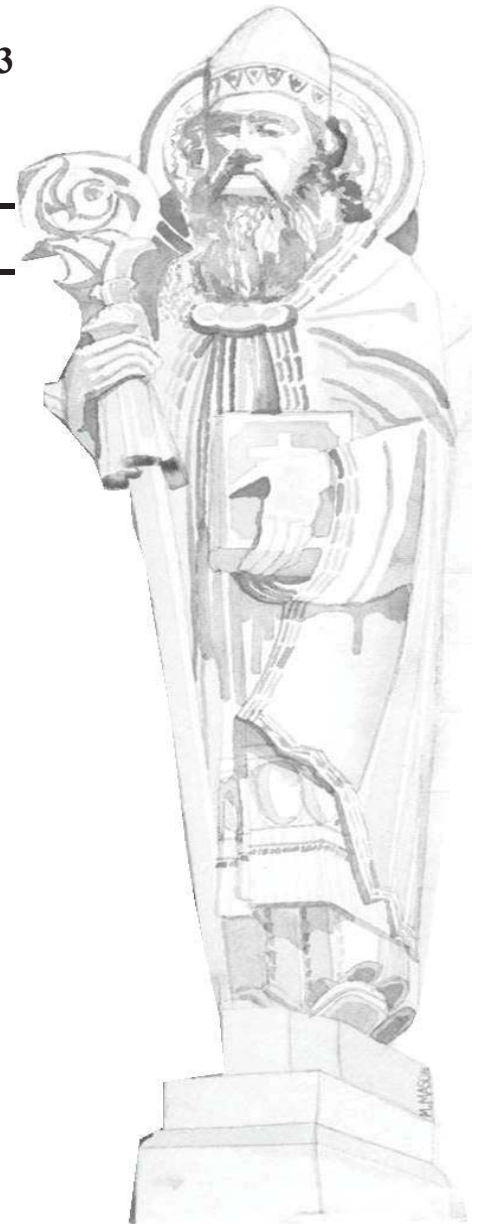

- 2) **You shall confess your sins at least once a year.**
- 3) **You shall humbly receive Jesus in the Holy Eucharist at least during the Easter season.**
- 4) **You shall keep holy the holy days of obligation especially Sunday.**
- 5) **You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence.**
- 6) **You shall provide for the material needs of the Church.**

**WELCOME TO A SPECIAL VISITOR:** *In conjunction with the annual Mission Cooperation Program of the Diocese of Pittsburgh, Rev. Ayub Mwampela from the Diocese of Mbeya will be visiting St. Colman on the weekend of June 18/19. Mbeya is located in the Southwest corner of the Southern Highlands of Tanzania. About 200,000 of the population are Catholics. 50% of the population lives below the poverty level while 70% of the poor live in the rural areas, making poverty largely a rural area problem. The diocese was established in 1932. Schools, health care centers, orphanages and hospitals are initiated and run by the diocese. Father Ayub will preach at the masses seeking financial support for the mission of the church in his diocese. Your generosity is appreciated.*
