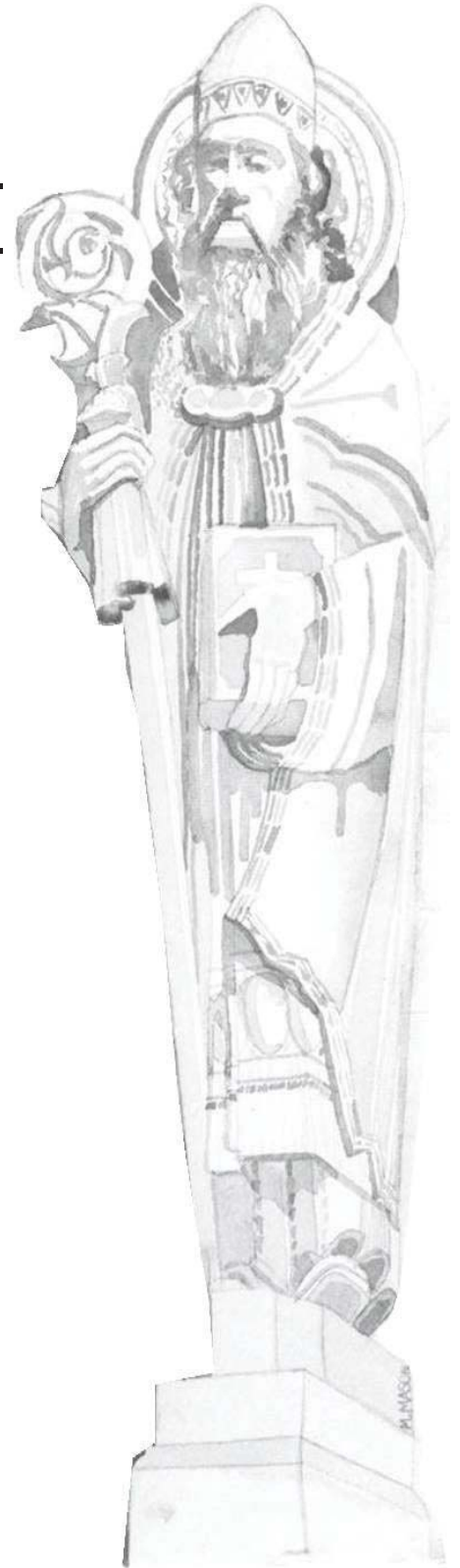

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

There is an analogy made between the earth and people. Just as God waters the earth to make things grow, we are "watered: by God's Word and grow in living out the Word's meaning. God has a purpose for the words that are sent to us. According to God's plan, we will achieve the purpose of that word. The fruit of God's harvest is divine in human beings - that is God's everlasting love. In the Gospel we are the soil in which God plants the seeds. Are we fertile or does our sinfulness or righteousness make us thorny? Are we filled with weeds of distraction and busyness? We need to be attentive to the care of our soil. That challenge is addressed in our prayer life, our attentiveness to the scriptures, our reception of the Sacraments and our efforts to live a life of service and charity in the image of Jesus Christ.
