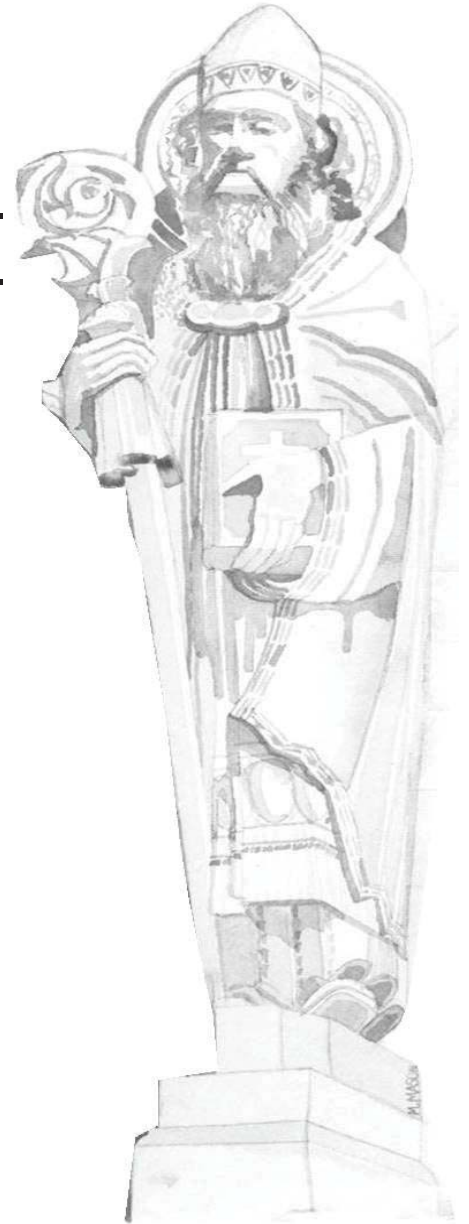

The Canaanite women should have been very upset. She pleaded in behalf of her sick daughter and he likened her and her people to the dogs of the household. But she didn't lose her cool and she didn't budge an inch. She kept pursuing her point and logically answered Jesus' objections. He was so impressed with her calm direct approach that he finally exclaimed "Woman, you have great faith," and cured her daughter immediately. Persistence can show a great deal of conviction and fortitude. Determination says a great deal about a person. It can say even more when faith moves one to the limits in pursuit of a desired goal the great saints of our history showed persistence in the face of challenges in their efforts to live the faith. It only remains for us to show the same enthusiasm and the persistence of the Canaanite woman when the challenges of the Christian message come our way.

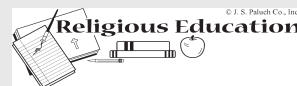
