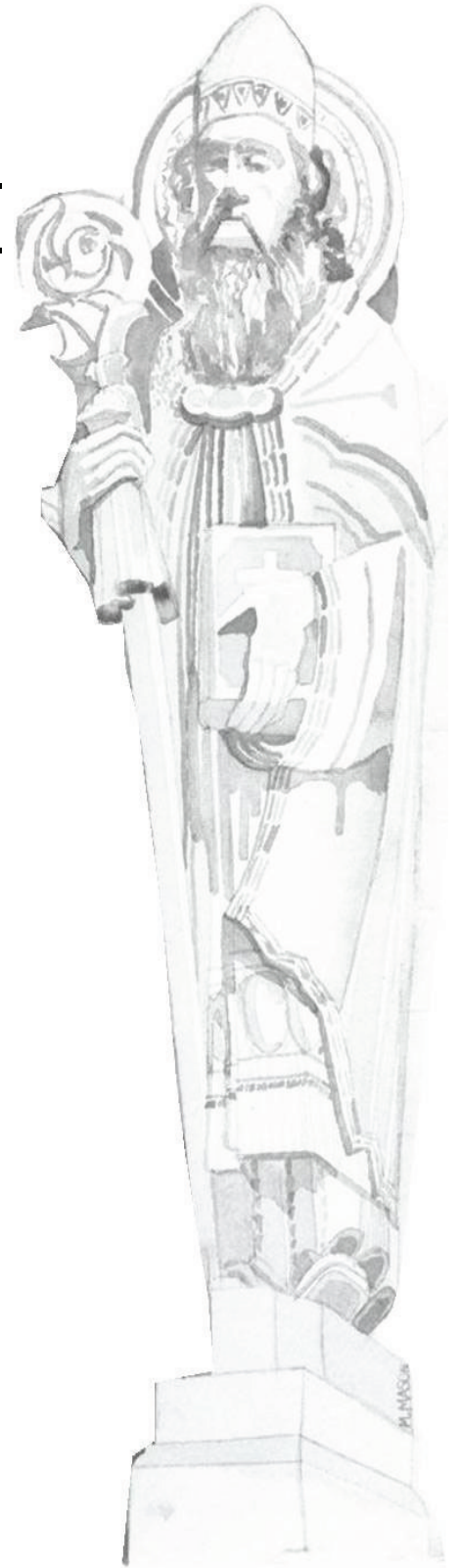

### TWENTY FIRST SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

*Jesus entrusted the early leadership of his followers to the apostle Peter. He was empowered to shepherd in the model of service that Jesus had lived.
